New master program in physical geography at the University of Bremen

The international and research-focussed master program "Physical Geography: Environmental History" at the Institute of Geography (University of Bremen) provides scientific expertise in the field of climate and environmental research against the background of past changes. The interdisciplinary approach includes courses (all in English) in physical and human geography, archaeology, geosciences, palaeobiology and environmental physics and links natural sciences with the humanities. To ensure high academic quality and practical orientation, the program draws on both, expertise within the University of Bremen as well as on partnerships with regional scientific institutions in Bremen and Lower Saxony, Germany. Research-based education is the cornerstone of this study program to train graduates for the international scientific job-market. Moreover, methodological training in the field, in the laboratory and on the computer, including geographical information systems, also qualifies for applied labour markets.
